## **Pool Information**

### **Guests:**

- Guest fees are \$8.00 for adults (14 years or older) and \$5.00 – under 14 years old..
- All guests must be accompanied by a pool member. Guests must be registered at the office and completely fill out the required paperwork.
- Each guest is allowed to attend 3 times per season.
- Guests must follow pool rules .

### **Swim Lessons:**

- Swim lessons are for pool members only.
- Swim lessons are weather-permitting only.
- Ask pool staff for swim lesson information.
- Certain areas of the pool are closed while swim lessons are being conducted.

### **Miscellaneous:**

- Ice cream and snacks are sold at the office.
- Soft drinks are sold in a vending machine near the exit of the changing rooms.
- Menu items may be ordered from the Members Tavern. Once the food order is ready, “Runners” from the kitchen will deliver your food at the pool. Your bill can then be settled using our Point-of-Service (POS) system.
- If entering the clubhouse, pool members and guests must be fully dressed.
- Do not allow your children onto the golf course.

# Berkshire Hills Country Club - Pool Rules

## Health Rules:

- Please shower before entering the water.
- No spitting or eliminating of bodily wastes in the pool.
- Swim diapers must be worn when not potty trained. Swim suits must be worn over swim diapers.
- No smoking, tobacco products, or electronic cigarettes in entire pool area. Smoking area is in parking lot only.
- No person with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections allowed in pool
- No person with communicable disease allowed in pool.
- No animals or pets allowed in the pool or on the deck

## Safety Rules:

- Children should not use the swimming pool without adult supervision
- Youths 12 and under who wish to use the deep end or diving board must pass a deep-end swim test.
- Diving area is for the diving board only. No front or back flips allowed. No diving in main pool.
- No running, boisterous or rough play. Do not throw your child in the air while in the pool.
- Water balls only. Tennis balls, rubber balls, water guns, squirt toys of any kind are prohibited.
- Only coast guard approved Personal Floation Devices (PFDs) allowed and must fit properly.
- Any non-swimmer or child wearing a life jacket must have an adult within arm's reach.
- Youths 12 and under are required to wear a wristband issued by lifeguards and used to distinguish swimming ability.
- Lifeguards will enforce additional safety procedures, condition dependent.

## General Rules:

- Food and beverages are permitted in the grassy areas. No food or beverages allowed in in pool or surrounding deck.
- No glass or china allowed in the pool or deck
- Bathing suits are required while in the pool. Shorts and cut-offs are prohibited.
- Lounge chairs are for Adult members over 18, unless you bring your own.
- Inserting umbrellas or stakes in the ground is prohibited.
- Adult swims are in the lap lane only. Please note that this is at the discretion of the Pool Director.
- No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool
- All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.
- Pool is for private use. Members and guests only
- Management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at anytime
